Civil Society Forum - Call for nominations

As part of the consultations towards the Ministerial Conference on CRVS in Asia and the Pacific, Plan International, ESCAP and World Vision are organizing a Civil Society Forum in Bangkok on 26 and 27 August 2014.

The Civil Society Forum is being held to offer a platform for representatives of national and international civil society and non-governmental organizations, particularly networks, alliances, and federations, to unite on the formation of a consolidated civil society statement that will be delivered at the Ministerial Conference and agree on joint actions to implement the declaration and regional action framework.



The criteria for participation are:

- Consultative status with the United Nations Economic and Social Council, or the endorsement of an organization that holds consultative status.
- Demonstrated engagement and experience in the improvement of CRVS systems and/or the promotion and protection of children's and human rights.
- Willingness to support the implementation of the Regional Action Framework for CRVS in Asia and the Pacific.
- Will be represented at the forum by its head or a senior official.
