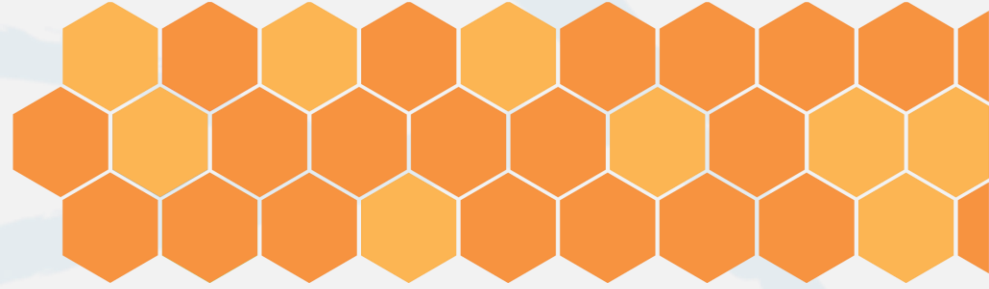

Pehchan Portal :Civil Registration System in Rajasthan

- Pehchan portal was launched by the Government of Rajasthan in September,2013
- Single Portal (<http://pehchan.raj.nic.in>) is being used by all the Departments authorized for registration and issuance of Birth, Death and Marriage certificates. The registrations are also being done through Mobile application.
- Access to Pehchan portal has been granted to all Nagar Palikas, hospitals and 45,000 e-Mitras.
- Once the form is filled and entry is made in the Pehchan portal, no separate approval is required for issuance of the certificate.
- All Government benefits are directly linked through Pehchan and is transferred to the citizens.
- 45,000 e-Mitras are being used as facilitators for registration of birth and death.
- All Gram Panchayats have been given access to Internet.



Administrative Initiatives

- Toll free lines and e-mail support is available for assisting the citizens w.r.t. registration.
- Necessary IT infrastructure and internet connectivity is available in all the units authorized for registration of birth and death.
- Apart from making entries online, departments also maintain a separate Register for Birth and Death registrations and have separate counters for the same.
- No manual certificate is issued by the Department.
- Regular trainings are being organized by the Department of Economics and Statistics for training the officials w.r.t. Birth and Death registration and issuance of certificate.
- QR code is available on birth and death certificate.



Integration with State Database: Bhamashah

- Integration of Bhamashah database with Pehchan - Bhamashah Scheme is an initiative of Government of Rajasthan to transfer benefits to the citizens of Rajasthan. The Bhamashah card contains details of all family members, their names, addresses, Aadhaar number etc.
- The guardian's Bhamashah id is captured while registering birth/death and hence a family register is maintained by linking Bhamashah with Pehchan
- Orders for integration of Voter ID with the Pehchan database has been issued by the Department. It has been proposed that election commission will be given access to this system to eliminate data of the deceased.
- Issuance of Birth and Death certificate through e-mail is being worked upon.
