Overview of questionnaire completion process

- Upon receiving the questionnaire- MBS approached Ministry of Health (MoH) to be a lead partner in questionnaire completion.
- Questionnaire reviewed by both agencies.
- To clear certain doubt online meeting held with ESCAP CRVS team.



Identifying and communicating with stakeholders

- Stakeholders identification carried out in consultation with Ministry of Health
- Institution reached out for questionnaire completion-

Identifying and communicating with stakeholders

- Official letter sent out from MBS to relevant agencies requesting all agencies to complete the questionnaire.
- An introductory session to the questionnaire was held with all relevant authorities on 25 July 2024.
- All agencies agreed to send their responses by 15 August 2024. This deadline communicated via email as well.
- Follow-up calls are being made from MBS to monitor the process, and provide assistance to agencies

Validating information and filling out the questionnaire

- Both DNR and LGA was given the option to provide micro data (and MBS does the computation) or they complete the responses with the data.
- To facilitate this, MBS shared a template for micro-data.
- Once responses is received from all agencies:
- MBS will validate the answers, will do one to one sitting with respective agencies to clear the doubt



Challenges encountered and solutions

- Legal aspects- current Act vs previous regulation
- Data retrieval- concern over receiving the 'right' data prior to the deadline
- Coordination important to carry out the process early on



Feedback for support on questionnaire completion

- DNR prefer MBS to compute the indicator- MBS to assist them once micro-data has been shared
- LGA proposed to give access to MBS to GEMEN platform to retrieve data and validate the responses shared by them
- MoH- requested for support in validating past responses and to recall activities carried out in recent years. Also to reflect on the future activities
