

Administrative Arrangements of the Philippine CRVS



Digital Transformation in the Civil Registry System: 2000 to present

Civil Registry System-Information Technology Project (CRS-ITP)

- Public-Private Partnership (PPP) under BOT
- Between NSO and Unisys Australia, Limited (Philippine Branch)
- 12 years contract from 23 December 1999 and extended until 04 September 2015
- 40 online CRS Outlets established nationwide
- Digital conversion of more than 100 million civil registry documents

CRS-ITP Phase II (CRS-ITP2)

- PPP under BTO, PHP1.586 Billion
- Between Philippine Statistics Authority and Unisys Managed Services Corp.
- 12 years contract from 30 September 2016 until 2028








CRS-ITP & CRS-ITP2 Accomplishments

... being able to serve an increasing number of clients (in 1,000)



 Increased in the percentage of transactions being served from the NSO/PSA computer database



Improved processing time of requested civil registry documents

... longer queues in the NSO Offices prior to CRS-ITP

- Converted birth/marriage/death records -from 7-15 working days to 1-2 hours
- CENOMAR from 15 working days to 5 working days to 1-2 days






CRS-ITP2 New Civil Registration Services

- Viewable Online
- DocPrint
- Premium Annotation
- Certificate of No Death (CENODEATH)
- E-cert or E-copy via Online Services (G to G)
- PSA e-Verification App (validation/authentication app)
- PSA Online appointment system

On release of vital statistics...

- Modification on the release of statistics on births, marriages, and deaths from quarterly to monthly including Press Release on the Causes of Deaths
- Official release of annual vital statistics reports from 2 years after reference period to 11, 12, and 13 months after reference period for marriage, birth, and death, respectively




CRS-ITP2 Infrastructure

RA 9048 and RA 10172 digital transformation

- V1.0 –Births and Death for Hospitals/clinics
- V1.1 Marriages for churches/temple/ mosques
- V1.2 LCRO full version
- V2- Shar'ia Court
- V3- Phil Foreign Service Post

- Barangay Civil Registration System set-up
- Develop a system to be used by BHUs, Brgy Secretaries in monitoring and reporting of VE to the Local Civil Registry Office

- Issuance of PSN upon registration of birth (timely)
- Linkage of the Birth, Marriage, Death Record in the PhilSys and CRS

- Online submission of petitions
- Upgraded database
- Easy tracking and monitoring of petitions
- Decentralized functions for the review of petitions





Challenges in the CRVS digital transformation

- Lack of a strong legal basis to impose local government units to use the PhilCRIS/e-PhilCRIS
- Lack of legal basis for e-registration or use of e-copies for registration of vital events
- Budget requirements to implement a full online registration system
- Administrative arrangements where Local Civil Registry Offices are under the Local Government Units
