









Asia-Pacific Civil Registration and Vital Statistics Decade, 2015-2024

1E: Recording of causes of death


3D: Reduction of ill-defined causes of death codes

3H: Publication of a vital statistics report









CRVS, an essential tool for disaster mitigation

- Natural disasters are major threats to civil registration systems
- Need to made resilient through:
 - Digitalization of records
 - Improvement of collaboration
 - Reform of the legal framework
- Robust CRVS systems can be critical in mitigating disasters
 - Response planning
 - Delivery of emergency services
 - Impact assessments


