Who is a stakeholder?

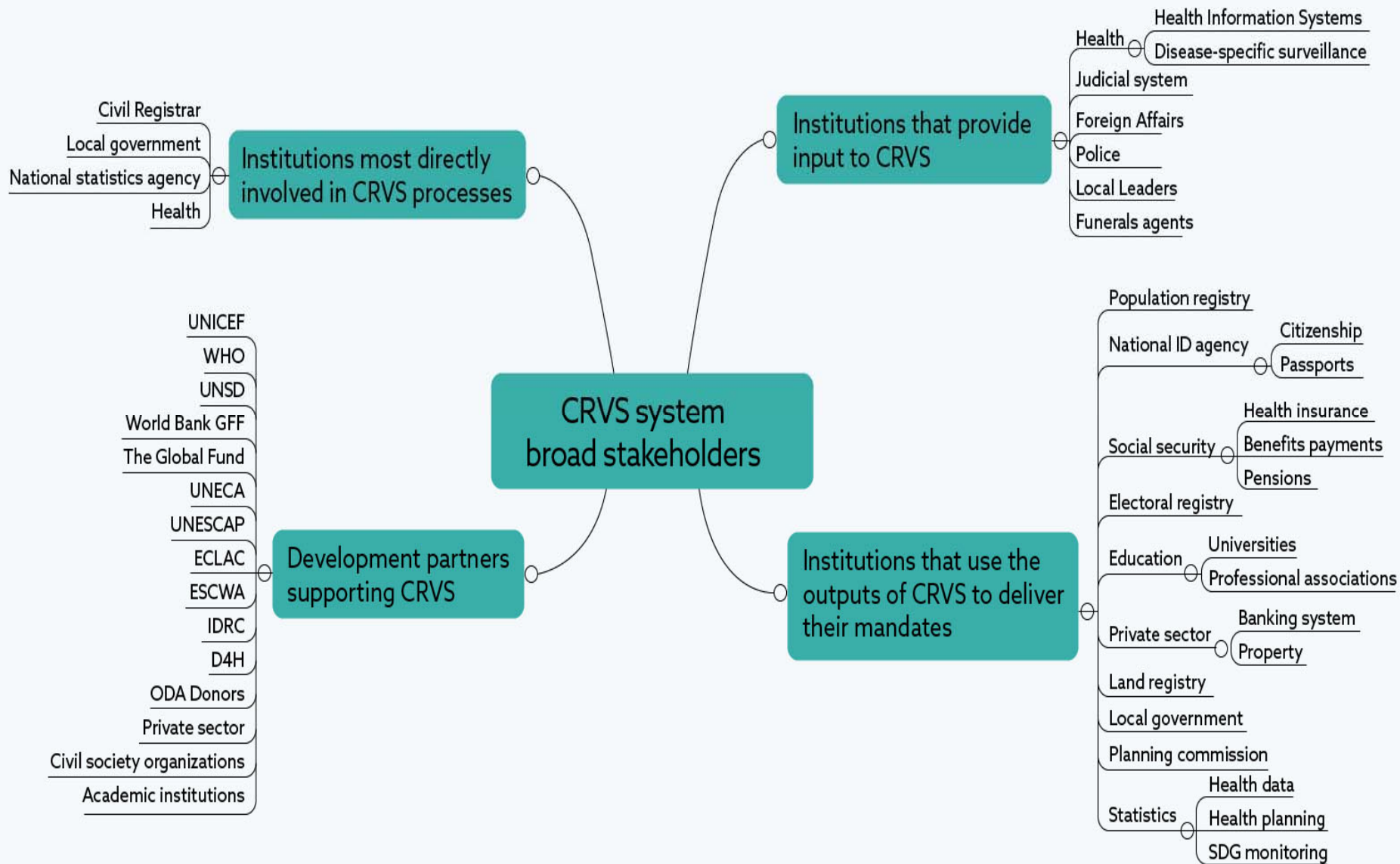
- ✧ A stakeholder is a person who has an interest of concern in CRVS (something to gain or lose)
- ✧ Stakeholders can be organizations, groups, departments, structures, networks or individuals
- ✧ Typical CRVS systems will include multiple stakeholders who work more or less independently



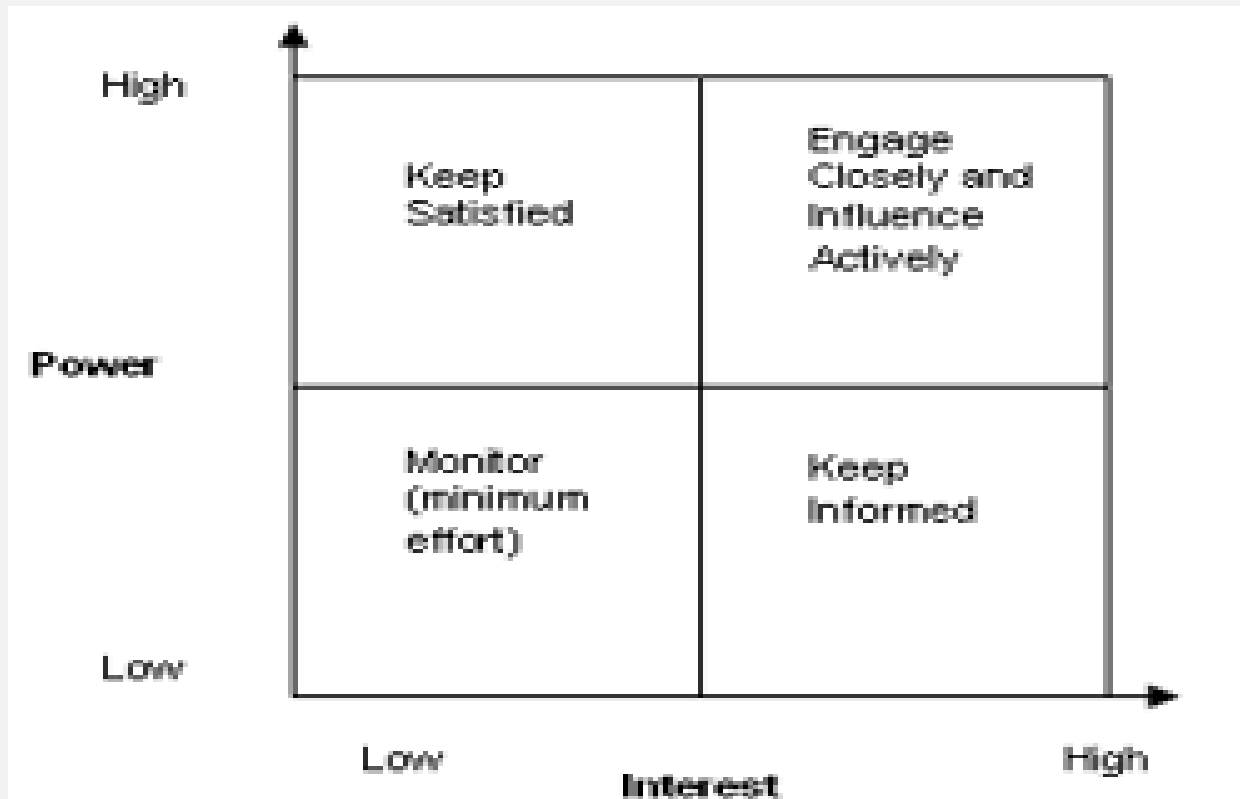
How to conduct a stakeholder analysis

-  Step 1 – Identify Your Stakeholders. The first step in your Stakeholder Analysis is to brainstorm who your stakeholders are (stakeholder mapping)
-  Step 2 – Prioritize Your Stakeholders (analysis matrix)
-  Step 3 – Understand Your Key Stakeholders

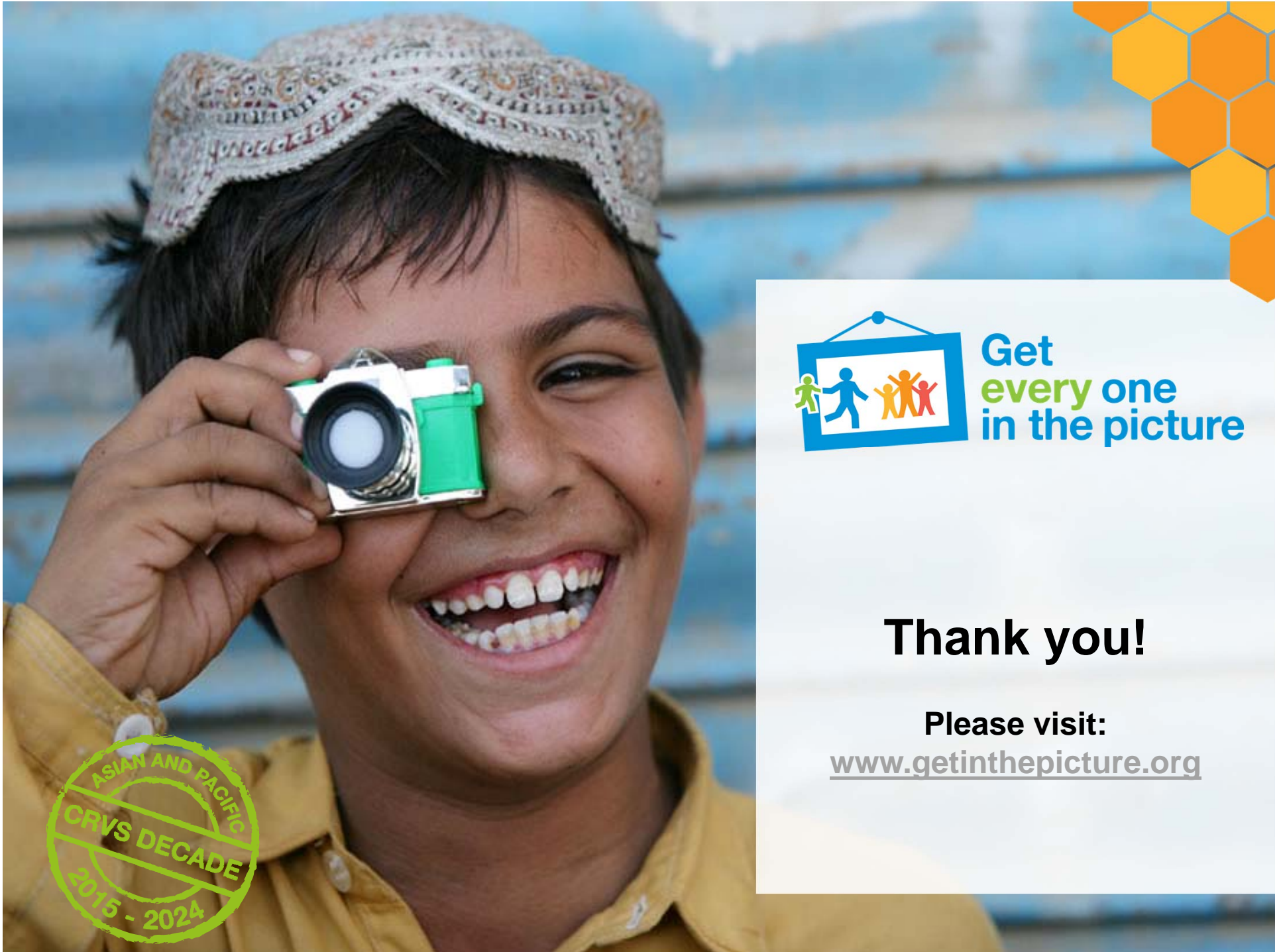
