Speaker Bio: Dr Stéphane Helleringer, New York University, Abu Dhabi

Prior to his current position as Professor of Social Research and Public Policy at New York University, Dr. Helleringer was Associate Director of the Population Studies Center, at Johns Hopkins University. He also held faculty positions at various universities within the field of Public Health.

With research interests in Demography, Epidemics and Mortality, Dr. Helleringer has worked extensively on the impact of HIV/AIDS, Polio, and Ebola in African countries. He has also conducted several trials of innovative approaches to collecting demographic data, and he has been an active technical advisor to inter-governmental agencies, including currently serving as a technical advisory group member at WHO for COVID-19 Mortality Assessment.

Dr. Helleringer is currently the principal investigator of multi-country studies aimed at improving estimates of adult mortality in low-income and lower-middle-income countries. He has authored numerous peer-reviewed articles and commentaries in the global health and demographic literature. Dr. Helleringer's education includes BA in Economics and Sociology, and PhD in Sociology & Demography.
